



CHAPTER 184

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Paul Allard to the practice of the profession of dental surgery

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1930]

WHEREAS Paul Allard, of the city and district of Preamble.
Montreal, doctor in dental surgery, has, by his petition, represented:

That in September, 1919, he was admitted among the students in dental surgery of Montreal University;

That he attended the regular courses of the said university for five years;

That on the 24th of April, 1926, the university granted him a diploma of doctor in dental surgery;

That after having obtained his degree of doctor in dental surgery he was prevented from passing his examination for admission to the practice of the said profession before the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, because he had not yet passed his examination for the admission to study of the said profession;

That, by reason of his studies and experience, he has acquired the necessary knowledge and qualifications to be admitted to the practice of dental surgery and to the exercise of the said profession;

That for major reasons it was impossible for him to present himself for the examination for admission to the study of dental surgery;

That the Board of Governors of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec granted him permission on the 24th of August, 1929, to apply to the Legislature of the Province of Quebec for the purpose of obtaining the passing of an act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the

Province of Quebec to allow him to practise his profession of dental surgeon in the Province of Quebec, after the examination for practice, but without the examination for admission to study;

That the petitioner has prayed for an act to be passed to the above effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Admission

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Paul Allard among its members, and to grant him the required license for the Province of Quebec, after examination for practice, but without the examination for admission to study, to enable him to practise the profession of dental surgeon in this Province.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
