



CHAPTER 185

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Stewart Alton Robinson to the practice of dental surgery

[Assented to, the 20th of March, 1930]

WHEREAS Stewart Alton Robinson, of the city and Preamble.
district of Montreal, Doctor of Dental Surgery, has, by his petition, represented that in June, 1920, he passed the matriculation examinations required for admission as a student in the Faculty of Arts at McGill University, Montreal;

That he attended regularly the sessions of lectures for the first year of Arts at McGill University during the session of 1921-1922;

That in October, 1922, he transferred from the Arts course to the Dental course, McGill University, being duly qualified so to do and continued his studies in the Faculty of Dentistry until April, 1927; during this period of time his studies were interrupted owing to serious illness;

That in April, 1927, he was obliged by circumstances over which he had no control to abandon his dental studies and he thereupon earned his living as a clerk;

That he obtained a diploma of Doctor of Dental Surgery from McGill University in May, 1929, after successfully following a four-year course in the said university and having graduated therefrom; but owing to illness and owing to the necessity of his having to do outside work apart from his studies and for other unavoidable reasons, he was unable to present himself for the examination for admission to the study of dentistry;

That from September, 1929, he has been attached to the staff of the Montreal General Hospital, dental department, in which department he is at present engaged;

That by his studies and his experience he has acquired the necessary knowledge and title to be admitted to the practice of dental surgery and to the exercise of the said profession;

That the Board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, on the 27th of December, 1929, consented to the passing of an act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to permit him to practise his profession of dental surgery in the Province of Quebec after undergoing an examination for the admission to practice, but without an examination for the admission to study;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act to that effect and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Stewart Alton Robinson among its members and to grant him the license required for the Province of Quebec to permit him to practise the profession of dentist in this Province, after examination for admission to practice, but without examination for admission to study.
