



## CHAPTER 4

An Act to authorize a grant to McGill University in respect  
of the training of teachers

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of the act 7 Grant to

twenty-five thousand dollars. Of such amount, not more  
than fifteen thousand dollars shall be used by the said  
Royal Institution for the purposes of the school for the  
training of teachers, at Ste. Anne de Bellevue, and not  
more than ten thousand dollars to provide, under one or  
more full-time Professors of Education at McGill University,  
courses for the preparation of candidates for the diploma  
qualifying them as high school teachers.

**2.** Such annual grants are hereby authorized for the Fiscal years
