



CHAPTER 4

An Act to authorize a grant to McGill University in respect of the training of teachers

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the act 7 Grant to Royal Institution for the Advancement of Learning. Edward VII, chapter 26, and of the schedule thereto annexed, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, each year, authorize the Provincial Treasurer to pay out of the consolidated revenue fund, to the Royal Institution for the Advancement of Learning, a sum of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars. Of such amount, not more than fifteen thousand dollars shall be used by the said Royal Institution for the purposes of the school for the training of teachers, at Ste. Anne de Bellevue, and not more than ten thousand dollars to provide, under one or more full-time Professors of Education at McGill University, courses for the preparation of candidates for the diploma qualifying them as high school teachers.

2. Such annual grants are hereby authorized for the Fiscal years included. current fiscal year and for the fiscal year beginning on the first day of July, 1927.

3. The acceptance of such annual grants shall not be Obligations not affected. considered as a failure on the part of the said Royal Institution for the Advancement of Learning to perform the obligations by it undertaken in the agreement of the 25th and 26th of February, 1907, and being the schedule to the act 7 Edward VII, chapter 26.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force. sanction.
