



CHAPTER 5

An Act respecting a certain grant of land to the Cistercian Fathers

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

WHEREAS the establishment, in the Gaspé region, of Preamble.
the religious order known as Cistercian Fathers
would be of benefit to the Province as regards the sale of
public lands, colonization and agriculture;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Minister of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries Grant of
is authorized to make a grant of land, not exceeding in land to
all two thousand acres, in the county of Gaspé, for the pur- Cisterian
pose of the said establishment, to the said Cistercian Fathers.
Fathers, either to them directly, or to some other person in
trust for them until such time as they shall have obtained
an act of incorporation if there be occasion therefor.

The said grant shall be so made subject to such conditions Conditions.
as the Lieutenant-Governor in Council shall consider the
best adapted to protect the public interest and to secure
the accomplishment of the purposes of an establishment of
that nature.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
