



CHAPTER 14

An Act to detach certain lots from the electoral district of
Dorchester and to annex them to that of Bellechasse,
and to legalize certain registrations in the registration
division of Bellechasse

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The lots known and designated under the numbers twenty-one to twenty-eight, inclusively, and their subdivisions, of the fifth and sixth ranges of the township of Buckland, in the electoral district of Dorchester, are detached from the electoral district of Dorchester and annexed to the electoral district of Bellechasse, for all purposes.

2. Paragraphs 7 and 18 of the table of the electoral districts, contained in section 7 of chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes, 1925, are amended accordingly.

3. Section 1 of the act 15 George V, chapter 13, is amended by adding thereto, after the words: "twenty-three-C", in the third line thereof, the words: "twenty-three-D".

4. The registrations affecting lots twenty-one to twenty-eight, inclusively, and their subdivisions, of the fifth and sixth ranges of the township of Buckland, made, by error, in the office of the registration division of Bellechasse, up to the coming into force of this act, are hereby declared valid, as if they had been registered in the division by law required.

5. The registrar of the registration division of Bellechasse must mention in the index to immoveables such of the registrations contemplated by section 4 which have not been mentioned in the said index, with the following note: "Entry authorized by 19 Geo. V, c. 14."

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
