



CHAPTER 16

An Act to amend the Legislature Act respecting travelling expenses of the members of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 87 of the Legislature Act (Revised Statutes, R.S., c. 3, s. 87, replaced. 1925, chapter 3) is replaced by the following:

“**87.** For each session of the Legislature there shall also be allowed to each member of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly, other than members of the Executive Council administering a Department, the sum of three hundred dollars for travelling expenses.”
Travelling expenses of members.

2. Section 88 of the said act is amended:

- a.* By striking out the second paragraph thereof;
b. By striking out the words: “and allowance”, in the sixth line of the third paragraph thereof.

3. The provisions of sections 1 and 2 shall apply as from the opening of the present session of this Legislature.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
