



CHAPTER 17

An Act to amend the Public Officers Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of February, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Public Officers Act (Revised Statutes, R.S., c. 9, 1925, chapter 9) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph: s. 4, am.

“If such suspension affects one of the joint-officers holding one or more of the offices mentioned in the second paragraph of section 2, the Attorney-General may, by letter, authorize the other joint-officer to remain alone in office and to continue, alone and in his own name, to perform the duties of the office without the necessity of appointing him anew or of granting him a new commission, and he shall so act until the authorization conferred by the said letter be revoked.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
