



## CHAPTER 17

### An Act to amend the Public Officers Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of February, 1929]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 4 of the Public Officers Act (Revised Statutes, R.S., c. 9, 1925, chapter 9) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"If such suspension affects one of the joint-officers <sup>Joint-officer</sup> holding one or more of the offices mentioned in the second <sup>authorized</sup> paragraph of section 2, the Attorney-General may, by <sup>to remain</sup> letter, authorize the other joint-officer to remain <sup>alone in</sup> office in <sup>office in cer-</sup> certain cases. <sup>tain cases.</sup> to perform the duties of the office without the necessity of appointing him anew or of granting him a new commission, and he shall so act until the authorization conferred by the said letter be revoked."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
