



## CHAPTER 29

### An Act to amend the Game Laws

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 4 of the Game Laws (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 86, chapter 86) is amended by replacing paragraph 5 thereof <sup>s. 4, am.</sup> by the following:

"5. to make use of dogs for hunting, killing or taking <sup>Use of dogs;</sup> moose, caribou or deer, on penalty of a fine of not less than forty dollars nor more than fifty dollars, for each offence;

No person owning, having or harbouring any dog <sup>Running at</sup> accused to hunt or pursue deer, shall allow such dog to run at <sup>large, etc.,</sup> large, hunt or course in any place frequented by deer, under <sup>of dogs.</sup> penalty of a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars. Any person may, without incurring any responsibility, kill any such dog found so unlawfully running at large, hunting or coursing in any such locality;"

**2.** Section 24 of the said act is amended by adding there- <sup>R. S., s. 86,</sup> to, after the word: "fire-arm", in the sixteenth line of <sup>s. 24, am.</sup> the third paragraph thereof, the words: "or hunting gear".

**3.** Section 38 of the said act is amended by adding <sup>Id., s. 38,</sup> thereto the following subsection: <sup>am.</sup>

"5. The Minister may withdraw, from a hunting lease <sup>Withdrawal</sup> already granted to a person or to a club incorporated under <sup>of land for</sup> special charter or under the Fish and Game Club Act (Chap. <sup>hydraulic</sup> 87), the land required for hydraulic developments or for <sup>develop-</sup> other industrial purposes. The compensation payable to the lessee by the company or individual who applies for such <sup>ments, etc.</sup> withdrawal of land shall be fixed by mutual agreement
