



CHAPTER 30

An Act to amend the Laurentides Park Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 10 of the Laurentides Park Act (Revised R. S., c. 88, Statutes, 1925, chapter 88) is amended by replacing the word: "five", in the third line thereof, by the word: "fifteen". s. 10, am.

2. Section 11 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph: Id., s. 11, am.

"Every person without such permit, found in possession of one or more of the fishing or hunting instruments mentioned in section 13, shall be presumed to have had such instruments to fish or to hunt; and every person without a permit found in possession of game or fish shall be presumed to have killed such game or caught such fish." Presumption as to persons found in possession of fishing or hunting instruments.

3. The said act is amended by inserting therein, after section 11, the following sections: R. S., c. 88, ss. 11a and 11b, added.

"11a. The following persons shall be liable to a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars with costs: whoever lends, gives, transfers or sells a badge for the purpose of facilitating the entrance to the park of any person who does not have a permit from the Minister of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries, or is not in the employ of a company operating within the park limits or whose presence in the park has not been specially required by such company; and every person using a badge so obtained shall be liable to the penalty provided in section 10 of this act. Persons liable to penalty.

Seizure by
ranger.

“**11b.** Every ranger may seize the fishing or hunting instruments as well as the canoes, boats and craft which he finds in the possession of one or more persons, without permit; and he may also seize automobiles or other vehicles used for transportation either of the fish or game taken in contravention of this act; he is authorized to retain possession of the things seized until the fine prescribed by this act has been paid.”

Coming into

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
