



## CHAPTER 32

### An Act to amend the Roads' Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Roads' Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 91) R. S., c. 91, is amended by inserting therein, after section 46c as enacted s. 46d, added by the act 18 George V, chapter 35, section 5, the following section:

**"46d.** The Minister of Roads may enter into agree-Maintenan-  
ments with any person who maintains wires on poles along ce, etc., of  
the roads with respect to the maintenance, trimming, trees.  
removal and replacing of trees growing near such poles  
and wires.

Whenever the Minister of Roads cannot agree with such Determina-  
person as to the contribution payable by the latter, the tion of con-

**2.** The said act is amended by inserting therein, after R. S., c. 91,  
section 81 thereof, the following section: s. 82, added.

**"82.** An amount of seventeen million dollars out of Appropria-  
the consolidated revenue fund is specially appropriated to tion for re-  
the carrying out of the programme of resurfacing, within surfacing of  
a period of six years from the 1st of July, 1929, of the roads,

**3.** The said act is amended by inserting therein, after section 104 thereof, the following section:

Acquisition  
of lands for  
certain pur-  
poses.

**"104a.** The Government of the Province, represented by the Minister of Roads, may purchase or lease lands or other immoveable property in order to place materials there and work same; to store vehicles, machines, implements and tools and repair them; to install scales, and have offices, and generally for all purposes in connection with the carrying out of this act.

**4.** Section 107 of the said act is amended by inserting therein, after the the word: "submit", in the seventh line thereof, the words: "or the interested party himself shall submit".
