



CHAPTER 38

An Act respecting the use of lamps or reflectors on animal-drawn vehicles

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows.

1. The Revised Statutes, 1925, are amended by inserting therein, after chapter 113 thereof, the following chapter: R. S., c. 113A, added

"CHAPTER 113A

"AN ACT RESPECTING THE USE OF LAMPS OR REFLECTORS ON ANIMAL-DRAWN VEHICLES

"1. This act may be cited as *Animal-Drawn Vehicle Lamps or Reflectors Act*. Short title.

"2. Every municipal corporation, whether governed by a general or special act, may make by-laws to compel the owner of any animal-drawn vehicle, and any other person in charge thereof, to provide such vehicle, when it is on a public road in the municipality, between an hour after sunset and an hour before sunrise, either with a reflector placed so as to receive the rays of light from a motor vehicle coming up behind and to warn the person driving such motor vehicle of its presence, or with a lamp lit and placed so that the light it produces be seen by the driver of a motor vehicle approaching the animal-drawn vehicle. Municipal by-laws for reflectors on animal-drawn vehicles.

Any by-law made by a municipal corporation under the authority of this section affects only the persons residing in the municipality governed by such corporation. Effect of same.

"3. Every owner of an animal-drawn vehicle or every person in charge thereof who infringes any by-law passed Penalty.

under the authority of this act shall be liable, in addition to costs, to a fine of at least ten dollars but not over one hundred dollars for a first offence, and of at least twenty-five dollars but not over two hundred dollars for each subsequent offence, and, in default of payment of the fine and costs, to an imprisonment of thirty days.

Provisions
applicable.

"4. The provisions of Part I of the Quebec Summary Convictions Act (Chap. 165) shall apply to this act."

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
