



CHAPTER 42

An Act to authorize the contribution by municipal corporations towards the erection of a monument to Sir Louis-Hippolyte LaFontaine

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advise and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follow:

1. The council of any municipality, in whatever manner Municipal incorporated and by whatever law governed, may pass a contribution by-law to provide for the contribution to the erection, to monument within the limits of the city of Montreal, of a monument in memory of Sir Louis-Hippolyte LaFontaine, and for the borrowing of the amount of money required therefor. L.H. LaFontaine.

Such by-law, when it provides for a loan, shall be subject to the provisions of the laws governing the municipality, except that the loan may be made repayable at a term of forty years. Loan by-law.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
