



CHAPTER 57

An Act to amend the *Habeas Corpus* Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the *Habeas Corpus* Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 167, 1925, chapter 167) is amended by striking out the second ^{s. 2, am.} paragraph thereof.

2. Section 3 of the said act is amended:

Id., s. 3, am.

a. By striking out the words: "and whether it be presided over by three or by five judges", in the sixth line of the second paragraph thereof;

b. By striking out the words: "and presided over by three or by five judges", in the third and fourth lines of the third paragraph thereof.

3. Section 7 of the said act is amended by striking out ^{Id., s. 7, am.} the words: "composed of three or five judges", in the fourth line thereof.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. _{force.}
