



CHAPTER 70

An Act to amend the Professional Syndicates' Act

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Professional Syndicates' Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 255, 1925, chapter 255) is amended by inserting therein, after ss. 6a-6c, section 6 thereof, the following sections: added.

“**6a.** When a syndicate wishes to change its name, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, on evidence, deemed by him sufficient, that such request to change the name is not made for an unlawful purpose, authorize the change of name prayed for in the petition addressed to the Provincial Secretary by the syndicate. Change of name of syndicate authorized.”

“**6b.** The Provincial Secretary, as soon as the authorization is granted, shall give notice thereof in the *Quebec Official Gazette*, as in form 2. Subject to such publication, but from the date of the authorization, the syndicate shall be designated under the new name mentioned in the authorization. Notice of authorization.”

“**6c.** No change of name effected under sections 6a and 6b shall alter the rights and obligations of the syndicate, and proceedings which might have been commenced or continued by or against the syndicate under its former name may be commenced or continued by or against it under its new name.” Change of name not to affect rights, etc.”

2. The said act is amended by adding thereto, after the form following section 19, the following form: R. S., c. 255, form 2, added.

“2.—(*Section 6b*)

“NOTICE OF CHANGE OF NAME

“(Professional Syndicates Act)

“Notice is hereby given that, under the Professional Syndicates’ Act, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council has, the day of 19 , authorized the (*here give the name to be changed*) to change its name to that of (*here give the name adopted*).
