



## CHAPTER 79

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting proceedings by way of injunction or mandamus against the Crown or the Ministers or officers of the Crown.

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by inserting C. C. P., art. therein, after article 87 thereof, the following chapter and *87a*, added. article:

### “CHAPTER VIIa

“INJUNCTION OR MANDAMUS AGAINST THE CROWN OR THE  
MINISTERS OR OFFICERS OF THE CROWN

“**87a.** No proceeding by way of injunction, mandamus or other special or provisional measure shall lie against the Government of this Province or against any Minister thereof or any officer acting upon the instructions of any such Minister for anything done or omitted or proposed to be done or omitted in the exercise of the duties thereof including the exercise of any authority conferred or purporting to be conferred upon same by any Act of this Legislature.”

No injunction, etc., against Minister, etc.

**2.** This act shall not apply to pending cases.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
