



CHAPTER 81

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting
inscription in law

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 195 of the Code of Civil Procedure is replaced
by the following: C. C. P., art.
195, re-
placed.

“195. No issue of fact can be inscribed before judg-
ment on the inscription in law, and such judgment must
dispose of the inscription in law without ordering proof
and without reserving it for decision on the merits.” Inscription
in law to be
disposed of.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its
sanction. Coming into
force.
