



CHAPTER 87

An Act to amend article 1143 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1143 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as C. C. P., art
enacted by the act 10 George V, chapter 79, section 16, ^{1143, am.}
and as amended by the act 13 George V, chapter 80,
section 1, is further amended by adding thereto the fol-
lowing paragraph:

“The defendant may avail himself of the provisions of ^{Provisions}

dered in the Superior Court, the Magistrate's Court or the
Circuit Court.”
