



## CHAPTER 89

### An Act to amend article 243 of the Municipal Code

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 243 of the Municipal Code is amended by M. C., art. replacing paragraph 3 thereof, by the following: 243, am.

"3. Have been in possession, in the municipality in which he or she seeks to exercise the right of an elector, either in his own name or in the name and for the benefit of his wife, as appears by the valuation roll in force, as proprietor, of immoveable property of the actual value of at least fifty dollars if he be a resident of the municipality, and of the actual value of at least two hundred dollars if he be a non-resident, or as resident tenant farmer or lessee, or as occupant by any title whatsoever, of immoveable property of the annual value of at least twenty dollars; and, in municipalities of the county of Saguenay, east of the river Betsiamites, as proprietor, tenant or occupant, of immoveable property of any value whatsoever;"
