



CHAPTER 93

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting the payment of municipal and school taxes

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Municipal Code is amended by adding thereto, M. C., art. 689a, added. after article 689 thereof, the following article:

“**689a.** Saving the provisions of article 689, any person, not being the debtor, who pays a municipal or school, Subrogation in the privileges of municipality. real estate or personal, general or special tax, or the water rates for a third party, with the consent in writing of the latter, is of right subrogated in the privileges of the municipality on the moveable and immoveable property of the debtor and may recover from him the amount of taxes so paid. Such subrogation shall be of no effect unless the receipt given by the secretary-treasurer of the municipality who is bound to issue such receipt states that the payment was made by a third party for the debtor. The name of such third party shall be noted in the books of the corporation.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force. sanction.
