



## CHAPTER 99

An Act to authorize the City of Three Rivers to arrange with the owners of properties burnt in 1908, to divide and pay the hypothecary obligations affecting such immoveables

*[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]*

**W**HEREAS Jos. L. Fortin, merchant, Charles and Léon Preamble.

Pagé, contractors, Alexandre and Simon Barakett, merchants, J. E. Dessurault, merchant, and Dame Henri Lajoie, of the city of Three Rivers, have, by their petition, represented that they are owners of immoveable property in the city of Three Rivers, affected by hypothecs for loans made to them and their *auteurs* as victims of the conflagration of 1908, in conformity with the acts 9 Edward VII, chapter 2, and 9 Edward VII, chapter 84, and with certain by-laws made under the said acts by the city of Three Rivers;

Whereas such hypothecs were granted in certain instances indivisibly on several immoveables;

Whereas it is doubtful whether those interested in the loans can receive a discharge from the city of Three Rivers freeing their immoveables from the hypothecs affecting them;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding any law, by-law or contract to the contrary, the corporation of the city of Three Rivers is empowered to make any agreement and settlement with the owners of immoveable property affected by hypothecs for loans made to the fire victims under the acts 9 Edward VII, chapter 2, and 9 Edward VII, chapter 84, and by-laws of the city, adopted in conformity with such acts, to City authorized to make agreement with owners in relation to certain obligations.

**2.** Any payment effected under this act must be deposited in the sinking-fund created under the law, to meet the debentures issued by the city, at maturity.

Coming into  
force.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
