



CHAPTER 102

An Act to annex certain immoveables to the parish of St. Michel Archange, and establish its boundaries

[Assented to, the 22nd of February, 1929]

WHEREAS the corporation called "The Sisters of Preamble. Charity of Quebec" has, by its petition, represented:

That the Quebec Asylum for the Insane, generally known as *L'Hôpital St. Michel Archange*, with its dependencies, was erected into a separate civil parish by the act 60 Victoria, chapter 72, assented to on the 9th of January, 1897, under the name of St. Michel Archange;

That the said parish then consisted of lots numbers five hundred and ninety and five hundred and ninety-one, of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Roch North, and of lot number seven hundred and thirty-seven, and the south-east part of lot number seven hundred and forty-six, of the official cadastre of Beauport, belonging to the corporation;

That the corporation subsequently acquired lots numbers five hundred and eighty-nine, five hundred and eighty-nine B and five hundred and eighty-nine C of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Roch North, on which are situated the Mastai Sanitorium and the Roy-Rousseau Clinic, and their dependencies;

That by contract passed on the 30th of October, 1913, before R. C. de la Chevrotière, notary, between the city of Quebec and the Sisters of Charity of Quebec, ratified by the act 4 George V, chapter 72, section 11, the corporation consented to the portions of lot seven hundred and thirty-seven of the official cadastre of Beauport and five hundred and ninety-one of the official cadastre of St. Roch North, situated to the south of Beauport road, being annexed to the city of Quebec, the latter undertaking in return to annex to the parish of St. Michel Archange, lots numbers five hundred and eighty-nine, five hundred and eighty-nine B,

and five hundred and eighty-nine C, of the cadastre of St. Roch North, which was done by the act 4 George V, chapter 72, section 12;

That at that time the corporation had already acquired as dependencies of *L'Hôpital St. Michel Archange* the two small lots numbers seven hundred and thirty-six and seven hundred and forty-two of the official cadastre of Beauport, which were annexed to the parish of St. Michel Archange, for religious purposes, with the lots numbers five hundred and eighty-nine, five hundred and eighty-nine B and five hundred and eighty-nine C of the official cadastre of St. Roch North, by a canonical decree of His Grace Monseigneur Louis Nazaire Bégin, then Archbishop of Quebec, dated the 3rd November, 1913;

That the corporation further acquired, as dependencies of St. Michel Archange hospital, lots numbers seven hundred and thirty-three and seven hundred and thirty-five of the official cadastre of Beauport, and has erected on the last lot the Lajemmerais school, intended for education of the mentally deficient;

That these immoveables have been annexed to the parish of St. Michel Archange for religious purposes by canonical decree of His Eminence Cardinal Rouleau, Archbishop of Quebec, dated 23rd December, 1928;

That, in the interest of the hospital work grouped in the parish of St. Michel Archange, it is important to annex the immoveables to the said parish for civil and municipal purposes, and to define the present boundaries of the municipality of the parish of St. Michel Archange;

That the corporation of Giffard village has given its consent to the annexation of the aforesaid lots to the parish of St. Michel Archange;

That the corporation has obtained the consent of His Eminence the Cardinal Archbishop of Quebec to this object;

That the corporation has prayed for the passing of an act for the above object, and

Whereas, it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Certain lots detached from Giffard and annexed to St. Michel Archange.

1. Lots numbers seven hundred and thirty-three, seven hundred and thirty-five, seven hundred and thirty-six, and seven hundred and forty-two, of the official cadastre of Beauport, are detached from the municipality of the village of Giffard, and are annexed to the parish of St. Michel Archange, for civil and municipal purposes.

2. After the coming into force on this act, the municipality of the parish of St. Michel Archange shall be bounded as follows: towards the northwest, starting at the northwestern extremity of the division line of lots numbers seven hundred and forty-six and seven hundred and forty-seven, by the south side of the front road of Petit Village, by lots numbers seven hundred and forty-four, seven hundred and forty-three and seven hundred and thirty-nine, of the official cadastre of Beauport, by the southwest side of the by-road leading to the front road of Petit Village, and by the south side of the said front road, from the said by-road to the intersection of the front road with the northeast line of lot number seven hundred and thirty-five; towards the northeast, by lots numbers seven hundred and thirty, seven hundred and thirty-one and seven hundred and thirty-two, of the official cadastre of Beauport, as far as Beauport road; towards the southeast by the Beauport highway; towards the southwest by lots numbers five hundred and eighty-five, and five hundred and eighty-nine A, of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Roch North, and by lot number seven hundred and forty-seven of the official cadastre of Beauport.

3. The by-road leading from Beauport road to the front road of Petit Village shall be kept by the parish of St. Michel Archange, and the front road of Petit Village shall be entirely kept by the village of Giffard.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
