



CHAPTER 111

An Act to amend the charter of *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis*

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

WHEREAS *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis* has, Preamble.
by petition, represented:

That it was incorporated by the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 118, for the objects mentioned in the preamble of the said act to which it refers;

That it is necessary to make a slight change in the constitution, the rules and by-laws of the community directing it having changed;

That one of the main clauses of the donation made by *Monseigneur* Charles Guay to the hospital, in view of its incorporation, allows the hospital to sell the moveable or immovable property given and to hypothecate the immovable property, provided that the proceeds of such sales or hypothecs shall be employed for the purposes of the hospital;

That it is necessary, therefore, to define in a clearer manner certain powers given it as to the alienation of its property;

Whereas, by its petition, *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis* has prayed for an act to this effect and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

“**1.** The superioress, Atala Morin, in religion Sister St. Paul de la Croix, and her four Councillors, Mathilda Four-^{incorpora-} tion.
nier, in religion Sister St. Stanislas, Albertine Duhamel, in

religion Sister Marie du Saint Sacrement, Rosanne Langlois, in religion Sister Marie de l'Annonciation, and Yvonne Carrier, in religion Sister Marie de Saint Omer, and such others as shall succeed them in office, shall constitute the corporation of *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis*, under the authority of the superioress-general of the *Institut des Sœurs de Notre-Dame du Bon Conseil de Chicoutimi* and of its council, and each of them may be removed and shall be replaced according to the rules and statutes of the said *Institut des Sœurs de Notre-Dame du Bon Conseil de Chicoutimi*."

3 Ed. VII, c. 118, s. 2, replaced. **2.** Section 2 of the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 118, is replaced by the following:

Property given to the corporation. **"2.** All the moveable and immoveable property already given to the said *Institut des Sœurs de Notre-Dame du Bon Conseil* by the said *Monseigneur* Charles Guay, or other persons, and also all the moveable and immoveable property which the said *Monseigneur* Charles Guay may leave at his death, and which he shall not have otherwise disposed of previous to his decease, shall of right be transferred to the said corporation of *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis*, and be by it enjoyed, done with and disposed of, managed, administered and employed according to the intentions of the donors and testators."

3 Ed. VII, c. 118, s. 3, replaced. **3.** Section 3 of the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 118, is replaced by the following:

Property devoted to purposes of the hospital. **"3.** All the property, moveable and immoveable, or all gifts or legacies whatsoever which the corporation of *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis* has acquired or may acquire or shall be made or assigned to it, shall always be devoted to the purposes of the said hospital, and no one whomsoever shall be, at any time, permitted to take away any portion thereof to be transferred elsewhere.

Power to sell, etc., property. Nevertheless, the corporation of *L'Hôpital Guay de Saint-Joseph-de-Lévis* shall have, and has always had, power to sell the said moveable and immoveable property and to hypothecate the said immoveable property, the proceeds to be employed for the objects of the hospital."

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
