



CHAPTER 130

An Act to ratify a resolution of the municipal council of the town of Lauzon, granting a fixed valuation for taxation purposes to George T. Davie & Sons for a period of years

[Assented to, the 4th of April, 1929]

WHEREAS George T. Davie & Sons, possessors of im- Preamble.
moveable property in the town of Lauzon, on the 30th of March, 1928, have represented to the municipal council of the said town that they intended to construct, on the said property, a Marine Railway, costing two hundred thousand dollars, if a fixed valuation for taxation purposes was granted to them for a period of ten years from the 1st of May, 1928;

Whereas the existence and operation of a marine plant of this nature would be of great advantage to the municipality of Lauzon, as it would give regular employment to a large number of workmen, and contribute considerably to the development of the municipality;

Whereas the municipal council of the town of Lauzon, on the 17th of April, 1928, unanimously passed a resolution to grant the said request of George T. Davie & Sons, subject to ratification of the Legislature;

Whereas, since the passing of the said resolution, George T. Davie & Sons have, in fact, constructed the said Marine Railway, and it will be ready to operate at the next opening of navigation;

Whereas George T. Davie & Sons pray for the confirmation and ratification of the said resolution;

Whereas it is expedient, moreover, to authorize the school commissioners of the said municipality to grant, by resolution, to the said firm, the same commutation for school taxes based on the above fixed valuation, for a period of ten years;

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Resolution
ratified.

1. The resolution passed by the municipal council of the town of Lauzon, at its meeting held on the 17th of April, 1928, by which the municipal corporation fixed the total amount of the valuation, for purposes of municipal taxation, of the assessable properties of the said firm, being the immoveables Nos. 215, 273, 273a, 274, 275, 35p, 49 and 176 of the official cadastre of the town of Lauzon, is hereby confirmed and ratified, in its entirety, for all legal purposes.

Commuta-
tion for
school taxes.

2. The school commissioners of the said municipality are authorized to grant by resolution, to the said firm, the same commutation for school taxes, based upon the same valuation for the same period of ten years.

Coming into

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
