



CHAPTER 147

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Antoine Philius Côté among its members, after examination

[Assented to, the 22nd of February, 1929]

WHEREAS Antoine Philius Côté, licentiate in law, of Preamble.
the city of Montreal, district of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That he made complete classical studies at the College of Levis and Quebec Seminary, in the Province of Quebec;

That he attended the entire courses of law given at Laval University, and successfully underwent the examination for the license in law and the degree of licentiate in law was granted by the said university;

That he attended special courses at Harvard University for the purpose of improving himself in the English language;

That his indenture was passed with Mtre. Joseph Ernest Grégoire, of Quebec, by deed before Mtre. Charles Delagrave, N. P., and that he regularly attended the office of the said Mtre. Joseph Ernest Grégoire during the period of his law studies;

That he never applied for his admission to the study of law, because he had no intention to practise the profession of advocate when he began his law studies, for at that time he had only in view the degree of licentiate in law and intended to follow journalism;

That, for financial and other reasons, he now wishes to practise the profession of advocate;

Whereas the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec has been made aware of all these facts, and the said Council granted his request to be allowed to present a bill at the then next session of the Legislature for the purpose of admitting him to the practice of law, after examination, immediately after the passing of such bill;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed for the above purpose and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Bar authorized to admit A. P. Côté.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Antoine Philius Côté among its members, and allow him to practise the profession of advocate, immediately after examination.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
