



CHAPTER 148

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries to admit Lucien Trempe to the practice of the notarial profession, after examination

[Assented to, the 22nd of February, 1929]

WHEREAS, Lucien Trempe, hitherto of the town of ^{Preamble.} Sorel, now of the city of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented:

That he is a British subject of the age of majority;

That he obtained from Montreal University on the 15th of September, 1926, the degree of bachelor of arts;

That, since the 15th of September, 1926, he has regularly attended the courses of the Faculty of Law of Montreal University;

That on the 21st of September, 1926, he was indentured to Mtre. George P. Laurin, notary, of the city of Montreal;

That his indentureship was duly registered at Montreal, in the office of the secretary of the Board of Notaries on the 22nd of September, 1926, under the No. 1,800;

That he is now a third year student of the Faculty of Law of Montreal University, and wishes to undergo the examination for the practice of the notarial profession, at the next session of the said Board of Notaries in July, 1929;

That for want of certain information, he could not present himself within the required delays before the Board of Notaries, for admission to the study of the notarial profession;

That he cannot, therefore, without the passing of an act, present himself for the final examinations of the Board of Notaries in July, 1929;

Whereas, the Council of the Board of Notaries, having been made acquainted with these facts, has permitted the petitioner to apply to the Legislature for the passing of this act;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in such petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Lucien Trempe is authorized to go before the Board of Notaries from the month of July, 1929, to undergo the examinations for the practice of the notarial profession, and is authorized to practise such profession as soon as he shall have successfully undergone such examinations.

Coming into
