



CHAPTER 3

An Act respecting the Court House of the District of
Quebec.

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Provincial Treasurer may, from time to time, advance and pay, out of the consolidated revenue fund of the Province, on the certificates of the Minister of Public Works and Labour, the sums required to pay, to the extent of a total amount of eight hundred thousand dollars, the cost of the necessary work which has been authorized by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to restore and improve the old portion of the court house of the district of Quebec, in the city of Quebec, according to plans and specifications which have been approved in the same manner. Restoration, etc., of court house in Quebec.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, if he deem it expedient for the purpose of paying all or part of the above-mentioned amount, authorize the Provincial Treasurer to contract a loan or loans not exceeding in all such amount of eight hundred thousand dollars, by means of bonds or inscribed stock issued on the credit of the Province. Loan authorized.

3. Such bonds or inscribed stock shall be issued at a rate of interest not exceeding five per cent per annum and shall be made for the term, in the form and for the amount which the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may determine, and be payable in interest and principal, yearly or half-yearly, at one or more places which he may indicate. Form, etc., of loan.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
