



CHAPTER 10

An Act to change the chief place of the county of Témiscouata and to establish it in the city of Rivière du Loup

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

WHEREAS the corporation of the county of Témiscouata has by its petition represented:

That the said corporation in regular meeting assembled on the respective dates of the 8th of June, 1927, and 14th of September, 1927, and the 14th of December, 1927, decided, by resolutions, to ask the Legislature to pass an act to transfer the chief place of the county of Témiscouata from Isle Verte to Rivière du Loup;

That on the 22nd of August, 1927, the council of the city of Rivière du Loup passed a resolution approving of such change;

That Rivière du Loup is the most important centre of the county of Témiscouata and best geographically situated to be the chief place of the county;

That the registry office for the county of Témiscouata has been at Rivière du Loup for the past thirty years, and said place is also the judicial chief place of the district of Kamouraska;

That, at a special meeting of the council of the county of Témiscouata, held at Isle Verte, the resolutions of the 8th of June, 1927, 14th of September, 1927, and 14th of December, 1927, were confirmed;

Whereas the above change is in the public interest, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioner;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The chief place of the county of Témiscouata shall Chief place

Témis- hereafter be in the city of Rivière du Loup, instead of
couata. being in the parish of Isle Verte.

Cost of act. **2.** The cost of this present act shall be borne by the
 corporation of the county of Témiscouata.

Coming into **3.** This act shall come into force on the first day of
force. April, 1928.
