



CHAPTER 19

An Act to amend the Beneficiaries Seizin Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Beneficiaries Seizin Act (Revised R. S., c. 30, Statutes, 1925, chapter 30) is amended by adding thereto, ^{s. 2, am.} after the word: "provided", in the eleventh line thereof, the words: "and no heir may effect a transfer, unless he has previously had himself put in possession in conformity with this act".

2. Section 3 of the said act is amended by adding ^{Id., s. 3, am.} thereto, after the word: "provided", in the twelfth line thereof, the words: "and no executor, trustee, administrator, curator or legatee may effect a transfer or the payment of the legacies, unless the legal delivery has been previously obtained in conformity with this act".

3. The said act is amended by inserting therein, after ^{Id., s. 3a, added.} section 3 thereof, the following section:

"**3a.** Every executor, trustee, administrator, curator, ^{Fine.} heir or legatee, as aforesaid, who violates the provisions of this act shall be liable to a fine equal to twice the amount of the fee exigible under this act."

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc- ^{Coming into force.} tion.
