



## CHAPTER 25

### An Act to amend the Alcoholic Liquor Act

*[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 56 of the Alcoholic Liquor Act (Revised R. S., c. 37, Statutes, 1925, chapter 37), as amended by the act 16 s. 56. am. George V, chapter 21, section 6, is again amended:

*a.* By adding thereto, after paragraph 21 thereof, the following:

“22. without lawful excuse, is found in an establish-<sup>Offence.</sup>ment where alcoholic liquor is sold without a permit; or”;

*b.* By replacing the number “22.”, in the first line of the twenty-second paragraph thereof, by number “23.”.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup>sanction. <sub>force.</sub>
