



## CHAPTER 27

### An Act to amend the Lands and Forests Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 70 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 44) is replaced by the following: R. S., c. 44, s. 70, replaced.

**"70.** No license shall be granted for longer than twelve months; but every license shall be subject to renewal in accordance with the regulations made, from time to time, by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, and after such renewal such license shall be effective and be deemed to have existed, without interruption, from the date fixed by such regulations. Term of license; renewal.

If in consequence of any incorrectness of survey or other error or cause, a license be found to comprise lands included in a license of a prior date, the license last granted shall be null insofar as it interferes with the one previously issued. Nullity of license in certain case.

The holder or owner of the license so become null shall not have any recourse whatsoever against the Government for indemnity or compensation by reason of such nullity." Idem.

**2.** Every license heretofore issued and every renewal thereof heretofore made shall be deemed to have been validly issued or renewed, and every renewal shall be deemed to have taken effect as from the first of May of the year for which it was made. Validation.

**3.** This act shall not affect pending cases.

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
