



## CHAPTER 43

### An Act to amend the Peddlers' Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Peddlers' Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter R. S., c. 126, 126) is amended by adding thereto, after section 9 thereof, s. 10, added. the following section:

**"10.** This act shall not apply to local municipalities where business taxes or licenses are imposed by by-law under the provisions of the Municipal Code or of the Cities and Towns' Act. Where act not applicable.

The license imposed under the provisions of this act shall not be issued nor its amount collected unless the peddler has previously obtained, from the collector of revenue for the proper district, a peddler's license in conformity with the Quebec License Act (Chap. 25) for the same license year, and unless such peddler has previously shown such peddler's license to the municipal officer, appointed to issue a license under the provisions of this act and to collect the amount thereof." Prior formalities to obtain license.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
