



CHAPTER 44

An Act to amend the Education Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 133, 1925, chapter 133) is amended by adding thereto, after the s. 4, am. word: "Court", in the sixth line thereof, the words: "notary, mayor or municipal councillor, or by the secretary-treasurer of a school municipality".

2. The said act is amended by inserting therein, before Id., s. 151a, added. section 152 thereof, the following section:

"151a. The school commission may, by resolution, Mode of order that the voting at elections shall be effected by ballot voting. in place of by word of mouth; it may also, in the same manner, reestablish the method of voting by word of mouth.

Every such change must be made at least six months Idem. before the date of the election at which it is to apply."

3. Section 152 of the said act is amended by replacing R. S., c. 133, s. 152, am. the first paragraph thereof by the following:

"152. In every school municipality where the election Mode of of school commissioners and trustees is held by ballot, if, voting. at the meeting held for such election, a vote has to be taken, such voting shall be effected in conformity with the provisions of this subdivision 5."

4. Section 285 of the said act, as amended by the act R. S., c. 133, 16 George V, chapter 40, section 2, is again amended by s. 285, am. adding thereto, after the word: "age", in the tenth line thereof, the words: "and shall indicate the number of them,

in each category, who attend school outside of the municipality”.

R. S., c. 133, s. 337, replaced. **5.** Section 337 of the said act is replaced by the following:

Collection, etc., of moneys. **“337.** The secretary-treasurer shall collect all the moneys payable to the school corporation and shall deposit them, in the name and to the credit of the corporation, in a chartered bank having an office in the municipality; and, if there be no such bank, he shall keep them as depositary, unless the school corporation orders otherwise.”

R. S., c. 133, s. 338, am. **6.** Section 338 of the said act is amended, by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

Payment by cheque. **“Every** such payment, in the case of moneys deposited in a bank, shall be made by cheque signed by the chairman and countersigned by the secretary-treasurer.”

R. S., c. 133, s. 457, am. **7.** Section 457 of the said act is amended by inserting therein, after the word: “respective”, in the fourth line thereof, the words: “chairmen and”.

Id., s. 529, replaced. **8.** Section 529 of the said act is replaced by the following:

Years of service included in fixing pension. **“529.** When fixing the amount of the pension, the number of years of service from the date of the diploma shall be included, or, if the officer obtained his diploma after beginning service, from the age at which diplomas were granted at the time the officer entered service.

Applications. This section shall apply to applications for pensions filed after the 1st of July, 1926.”

R. S., c. 133, s. 561, am. **9.** Section 561 of the said act is amended by adding thereto, after the fourth paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

Interpretation. **“By** “convention of Roman Catholic teachers in Montreal” is meant the association of teachers of the Jacques-Cartier Normal School district, and by “convention of Roman Catholic teachers in Quebec” is meant the association of teachers of the Laval Normal School district.”

Coming into force. **10.** This act shall come into force of the day of its sanction.
