



CHAPTER 48

An Act respecting a certain subsidy to *Les Écoles Ménagères Provinciales*

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may, subject ^{Grant of} to the conditions hereinafter set forth, authorize the Provincial Treasurer to pay, out of the consolidated revenue fund, ^{certain sub-} ^{sidy to Les} for a period of thirty years, to the section of the lady ^{Ecoles Mé-} ^{nagères Pro-} ^{vinciales.} patronesses of "*La Société Saint Jean Baptiste de Montréal*", designated under the name of *Les Écoles Ménagères Provinciales*, created under section 30c of the act 51-52 Victoria, chapter 65, as enacted by the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 93, section 1, and maintained in force by the act 3 George V, chapter 93, section 21, an annual grant of two thousand five hundred dollars.

The grant of such subsidy shall be subject to the con- ^{Conditions.} dition that the said corporation, *Les Ecoles Ménagères Provinciales*, shall acquire an immoveable property, to give courses therein, in domestic science, and that such courses, at least equivalent to those heretofore given by them, be there continued, each year, for the said period of thirty years.

Such period of thirty years for which the subsidy is ^{Mode of} granted shall begin to run during the present fiscal year, ^{payment.} 1927-1928. The subsidy shall be paid each year, after the adoption of the order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon certificate of the Minister of Agriculture attesting that the corporation has fulfilled the above-mentioned conditions, unless the Lieutenant-Governor in Council annuls the subsidy for failure to accomplish the said conditions.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
