



CHAPTER 53

An Act to exempt the school commissioners for the municipality of the city of Outremont, in the county of Westmount and Montreal-Laurier, from the effect of certain acts

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

WHEREAS the school commissioners for the municipality of the city of Outremont, in the counties of Westmount and Montreal-Laurier, expend yearly, for the education of each child attending schools under their control, a sum appreciably higher than that devoted to the same purpose by other school municipalities of the Island of Montreal; Preamble.

Whereas the certificate of the inspectors of the Department of Education attest to the high degree of efficiency of the schools under the control of the petitioners;

Whereas there is no occasion to subject the petitioners to the application of the second paragraph of subsection 2 of section 16 of the act 15 George V, chapter 45, as replaced by the act 17 George V, chapter 42, section 2;

Whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The second paragraph of subsection 2 of section 16 of the act 15 George V, chapter 45, as replaced by the act 17 George V, chapter 42, section 2, shall not apply to the school commissioners for the municipality of the city of Outremont, in the counties of Westmount and Montreal-Laurier, from and after the 1st of July, 1927, and the payments made to them by the city of Outremont of their proportion of taxes from the neutral panel during the school years 1925-1926, 1926-1927 and 1927-1928 are hereby ratified. Provision not applicable to school commissioners of Outremont.
Validation of payments made.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
