



CHAPTER 56

An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act respecting the concurrent jurisdiction of the Courts in the judicial districts of Kamouraska, Rimouski and Saguenay

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The title of subdivision 13 preceding section 141 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is replaced by the following: R. S., c. 145, title of subdiv. 13, replaced.

“§13.—*Provisions respecting the North Shore between les Bergeronnes and Portneuf and from Portneuf to Blanc-Sablon and the Island of Anticosti.*”

2. Section 141 of the said Courts of Justice Act is Id., s. 141, am. amended by replacing the first paragraph thereof by the following:

“**141.** The civil courts and the judges thereof sitting at Rivière-du-Loup, in the electoral district of Temiscouata, in the judicial district of Kamouraska, shall have concurrent civil jurisdiction with the courts and judges of the district of Saguenay, in all civil suits within their jurisdiction, arising in that part of the North Shore between les Bergeronnes and Portneuf inclusively. Concurrent civil jurisdiction of courts at Rivière-du-Loup.”

The civil courts and the judges thereof, sitting at Rimouski, in the electoral district of Rimouski, in the judicial district of Rimouski, shall have concurrent civil jurisdiction with the courts and judges of the district of Saguenay, in all civil suits within their jurisdiction, arising in that part of the North Shore situated to the east of Portneuf up to and including Blanc-Sablon, and in the Island of Anticosti, in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.” Id., at Rimouski.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
