



CHAPTER 66

An Act to amend the Fire Prevention Act

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 13a of the Fire Prevention Act (Revised R. S., c. 180, Statutes, 1925, chapter 180), as enacted by the act 18 s. 13a, replaced. George V, chapter 65, section 6, is replaced by the following:

“13a. Every fire insurance company doing business in the Province shall furnish, at the end of each month, to the Provincial Fire Commissioner, from the 1st of July, 1928, on special forms supplied therefor, a report on every fire occurring in the Province, in which the company is interested as insurer, indicating, in each case, the name of the insured, his address if possible, the situation of the property or risk insured, the value of the property affected by the different items of the policy, the amount of insurance in force and amount of the loss. Such report shall be addressed to the Provincial Fire Commissioner within the first fifteen days of each month.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
