



CHAPTER 81

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1925, respecting Daylight Saving

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Standard Time Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 276, chapter 276) is amended by adding thereto, after section ^{s. 5, added.} 4 thereof, the following section:

"5. When a municipality has asked for the change of Time to be standard time for a year and an order-in-council has been ^{changed} passed in accordance with such request, the standard time ^{between} shall remain changed for the succeeding years as regards ^{certain} such municipality, with the exception that daylight saving ^{dates.} so enacted shall take effect from the first Saturday in May, at midnight, and shall cease to have effect on the last Saturday in September, at midnight, whatever period of time was originally fixed in the order-in-council for such first year. Such change shall so continue from year to year until the council of the municipality shall have, by resolution, expressed its volition to terminate for the future the change in standard time or to alter it, and until an order-in-council shall have been passed in accordance therewith."

2. The provisions of this act shall apply to municipal- ^{Provisions} ities for which standard time, before the 15th day of ^{applicable.} March, 1928, was advanced one hour.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
