



## CHAPTER 82

An Act to amend article 44 of the Civil Code

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 44 of the Civil Code, as contained in article C. C., art. 5779 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, and replaced by the <sup>44, am.</sup> act 9 George V, chapter 71, section 1, is amended by replacing the second paragraph thereof by the following:

“In the case of Roman Catholic and Church of England <sup>Keeping of registers of civil status.</sup> churches, private chapels or missions, they are kept by any priest authorized by competent ecclesiastical authority to celebrate marriages or administer baptism and perform the rights of burial, and, in the case of The United Church of Canada churches, private chapels or missions, they are kept by any minister or pastor similarly authorized by the President of the Conference of the said United Church of Canada having jurisdiction over its ministers and pastors exercising their ministry in this Province.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into force.</sup> sanction.
