



CHAPTER 83

An Act to amend the Civil Code respecting registers of civil status

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The following article is inserted in the Civil Code C. C., art. after article 45: 45a, added.

“45a. Whenever registers of civil status have not been authenticated, numbered or initialled in the manner prescribed in the Code of Civil Procedure, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, in each particular case, indicate to the prothonotary the method of rectifying the irregularity committed. Rectifying of irregularity in registers of civil status.

Every register of civil status, irregularly authenticated, numbered or initialled, which has been rectified in the manner indicated in the Order of the Lieutenant-Governor, shall have the same authenticity, validity and effect as if it had been originally authenticated, numbered and initialled in accordance with the law in that respect.” Authenticity, etc., thereof.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
