



CHAPTER 84

An Act to amend the Civil Code respecting incapable persons

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Civil Code is amended by inserting therein, after C. C., art. article 348 thereof, the following article: 348a, added.

“348a. Whenever an incapable person domiciled outside of the Province possesses property or has rights to be exercised in the Province and the law of his domicile does not provide for him to have a representative as to his property or his rights, a curator to his property may be appointed for him to represent him in all cases where a tutor or a curator may represent a minor or an incapable person under the laws of this Province. The appointment shall be made in the district wherein the property or rights of the incapable person is or are wholly or in part situated, with the formalities and according to the rules prescribed for the appointment of tutors or curators to minors or to incapable persons domiciled in the Province.” Representation of incapable persons.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
