



CHAPTER 90

An Act to amend article 72a of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 72a of the Code of Civil Procedure, as enacted C. C. P., art.
by the act 11 George V, chapter 101, section 1, is amended ^{72a, am.}
by adding thereto, the following paragraph:

“If such petitions, applications or proceedings emanate ^{Petitions,}
from the district of Pontiac, they may also be presented ^{etc., from} in
the district of Hull to the judge when he is present there.” ^{Pontiac,}
