



## CHAPTER 90

An Act to amend article 72a of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 72a of the Code of Civil Procedure, as enacted C. C. P., art. by the act 11 George V, chapter 101, section 1, is amended <sup>72a, a.m.</sup> by adding thereto, the following paragraph:

“If such petitions, applications or proceedings emanate from the district of Pontiac, they may also be presented in the district of Hull to the judge when he is present there.”
