



## CHAPTER 91

An Act to amend article 598 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 598 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the acts 13 George V, chapter 79, section 1, and 14 George V, chapter 80, section 7, is again amended: C. C. P., art. 598, am.

*a.* By replacing paragraph 12 thereof by the following:  
"12. The things enumerated in the Settlers Protection Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 78).";

*b.* By inserting therein, immediately before the last paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

"Any renunciation whatsoever to the exemptions from seizure resulting from the above provisions is null and void, whatever may be the terms of the renunciation." Renunciation void.

**2.** This act shall not affect pending cases.

Pending cases.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
