



CHAPTER 92

An Act to amend article 599 of the Code of Civil Procedure
respecting sums of money and pensions given as
alimony

[Assented to, the 22nd of March, 1928]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 599 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amend- C. C. P., art.
ed by the acts 62 Victoria, chapter 53, section 1; 3 Edward 599, am.
VII, chapter 55, section 1, and 3 Edward VII, chapter
56, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto, after
paragraph 14 thereof, as enacted by the act 3 Edward VII,
chapter 56, section 1, the following paragraph:

“Notwithstanding any stipulation to the contrary, the Seizure for
sums and pensions mentioned in paragraph 4 may how- alimentary
ever be seized in execution of any judgment condemning pension due
the donee, the legatee or the beneficiary himself to pay an by donee,
etc.
alimentary pension or alimony.”

2. This act shall not affect instalments of alimentary Restriction.
pensions or alimony due under any such judgment before
the coming into force of this act.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
sanction. force.
