



## CHAPTER 135

An Act to ratify a resolution of the school commissioners and a by-law of the council of the city of Cap de la Madeleine, granting a commutation of taxes to the Canadian International Paper Company

*[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]*

**W**HEREAS the school commissioners of the city of Cap de la Madeleine have, by their petition, represented: Preamble.

That on the 17th of November, 1925, they adopted a resolution to fix the valuation of the property of the Canadian International Paper Company, used for industrial purposes, at the sum of fifty thousand dollars, for ten years from the 1st of July, 1926, for all purposes of taxation whatsoever;

That it was stipulated in the said resolution that it would come into force on the 1st of July, 1926, upon its acceptance by the company, and ratification by the Quebec Legislature at its next session;

That the company has accepted the said resolution, and in order to give it force and effect, it is now asking for its confirmation and ratification;

That the corporation of the city of Cap de la Madeleine, on the 14th of December, 1925, adopted its by-law No. 83, to fix the valuation of the property of the said company, used for industrial purposes, at the sum of fifty thousand dollars for twenty years from the 1st of January, 1926, for all purposes of municipal taxation whatever;

That the corporation of the city of Cap de la Madeleine on the 17th of May, 1926, passed its by-law No. 87 amending its by-law No. 83, making the period ten years instead of twenty years, for which such commutation of taxes was to endure;

That the said by-law was submitted to the approval of the electors who are owners of real estate, at a meeting held

for that purpose on the 9th and 10th of June, 1926, and that almost all, that is to say, all the electors except one, approved, both in number and in value, the said by-law;

That the company has accepted the said by-law, and, in order to give it effect, asks for its confirmation and ratification;

And whereas, it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The following resolution and by-laws, namely:

*a.* A resolution adopted by the school commissioners of the city of Cap de la Madeleine, dated the 17th of November, 1925, fixing the valuation of the property of the Canadian International Paper Company at the sum of fifty thousand dollars;

*b.* By-laws Nos. 83 and 87, passed and adopted by the council of the city of Cap de la Madeleine on the 14th of December, 1925, and 17th of May, 1926, fixing the valuation of the property of the Canadian International Paper Company at the sum of fifty thousand dollars,—

Are confirmed and ratified for all legal purposes.
