



## CHAPTER 138

An Act to ratify by-law No. 72 by which the corporation of the town of Arthabaska grants a bonus of four thousand dollars to the Arthabaska Clothing Company

*[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]*

**W**HEREAS the municipal council of the corporation of the town of Arthabaska, at a meeting regularly held on the 19th of April, 1927, adopted a by-law granting a bonus of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) to the Arthabaska Clothing Company, for the establishment of a clothing factory in the said town on the conditions set forth in the said by-law;

Whereas the said by-law was submitted to the municipal electors of the said town for approval, and the latter have unanimously declared themselves in favour of the grant;

Whereas the municipal council of the said town desires to have the said by-law confirmed and ratified, notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes, 1925;

Whereas the said by-law was adopted by the municipal council under the impression it had the right to grant such bonus, and, the payment having been made, the manufacture was put into operation;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The said by-law No. 72 of the corporation of the town of Arthabaska is ratified and confirmed for all legal purposes.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
