



CHAPTER 152

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Charles Stanislas Victorien Barré to the practice of law.

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

WHEREAS Charles Stanislas Victorien Barré, student, Preamble.
of the city and district of Montreal, has, by his petition represented:

That he is a British subject of the age of maturity;

That he attended for two years the Faculty of Arts course of McGill University, and afterwards entered the Faculty of Law of the said university, and, after having undergone the matriculation examination, he obtained the degrees of LL.B., and B.C.L.

That your petitioner then intended to practise the profession of advocate in the West;

That he then established himself in British Columbia, where he was admitted as a student at law;

That, in accordance with the law of the place, he had to serve a certain period before presenting himself for the Bar examination;

That for family reasons, he had to return to the Province of Quebec, and is now definitely established here;

That he desires now to take advantage of the education which he received at McGill University;

That the General Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, at its meeting held in Montreal on the fourth day of the month of June, 1927, approved and recommended the passing of an act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit him to the practice of law, after successfully undergoing the regular examination for admission to the practice of law, and after one year of clerkship, to be computed from the authorization of the General Council;

Whereas, the said Charles Stanislas Victorien Barré has

prayed for the passing of an act to the above effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows;

Bar authorized to admit C. S. Victorien Barré.

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Charles Stanislas Victorien Barré to the practice of law, after he has undergone successfully the regular examination for admission to the practice of law, after one year of clerkship, to be computed from the date of the authorization of the General Council.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
