



CHAPTER 153

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit L. E. Langis Galipeault amongst its members, after examination

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1928]

WHEREAS L. E. Langis Galipeault, student at law, ^{Preamble,} of the Province of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented: that he is a Bachelor of Science and has made complete classical studies at the Quebec Seminary, and that since the year 1925 he has attended the lectures on law at Laval University, Quebec, and has successfully passed all its examinations to date;

That on the 7th of July, 1925, he was indentured to the Honourable Antonin Galipeault, K.C., of Quebec, and has regularly attended his office as clerk;

That as his law studies are to terminate at the end of the scholastic year, 1928, he would normally present himself for admission to the practice of law at the July examinations of 1928;

That he only obtained his degree of Bachelor of Science in September, 1927, and his admission to the study of law in January, 1928;

That he cannot practise the profession of advocate immediately, even if he successfully passed the final examination for admission to practice, inasmuch as he only obtained his certificate for admission to study in January, 1928;

Whereas the above facts have been brought to the knowledge of the General Council of the Bar of the Province, and the said Council granted his request for permission to present a bill at the then next session of the Legislature to admit him to the practice of law, after examination, immediately after the passing of such bill;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed for an act to that effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit L. E. Langis Galipeault among its members, and to permit him to practise the profession of advocate, immediately after examination.
